If articles are submitted in Azerbaijani or Russian, the abstract must be in English.*

Summary (Times New Roman, 10 pt, normal, capitalize, black, align justify, single space)

A brief summary of the manuscript (approximately 150–250 words). The abstract should clearly state the objective, methods, key results, and main conclusions of the study. Avoid references and undefined abbreviations.

Keywords: Provide 3–6 keywords that reflect the main topics of the manuscript

Introduction

Provide background information on the topic, outline the current state of research, and clearly state the aim or objective of the study. The introduction should be concise and relevant.

Materials and Methods

Describe the study design, participants or materials, procedures, and analytical methods in sufficient detail to allow replication. Include information on ethical approval where applicable.

Results

Present the findings of the study clearly and logically. Use tables and figures where appropriate, but avoid duplication between text and visuals.

Discussion

Interpret the results in the context of existing literature. Highlight the significance of the findings, discuss limitations, and suggest directions for future research.

Conclusion

Summarize the main findings and their implications. Avoid repeating information already stated in the abstract.

Acknowledgments (if applicable)

Recognize individuals or institutions that contributed to the work but do not meet authorship criteria.

References

List all references cited in the manuscript. Ensure consistency in formatting. A standard format is recommended (e.g., Vancouver style):

1. Author(s). Title of article. Journal Name. Year; Volume(Issue) numbers.
2. Author(s). Title of book. Edition. Place of publication: Publisher; Year.

Tables and Figures

Tables should be numbered consecutively and include clear titles.

Figures should be high quality and submitted separately where required. Each table and figure must be cited in the text. Images must be high-resolution (≥ 300 dpi).

Formatting Notes (body paragraph)

Use a standard, readable font (Times New Roman, 12 pt, Line spacing: 1.5)

Margins of 2.5 cm at the top and bottom, and 1.5 cm on the left and right sides.

Pages should be numbered consecutively
Use clear headings and subheadings
